



Across the school we have been learning about feeling safe and happy at New City. Below are some examples of children's work.

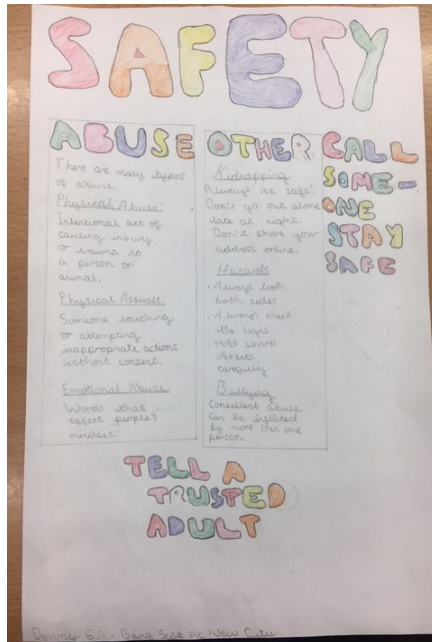
### Feeling Safe at New City

There are so many things you're not very sure

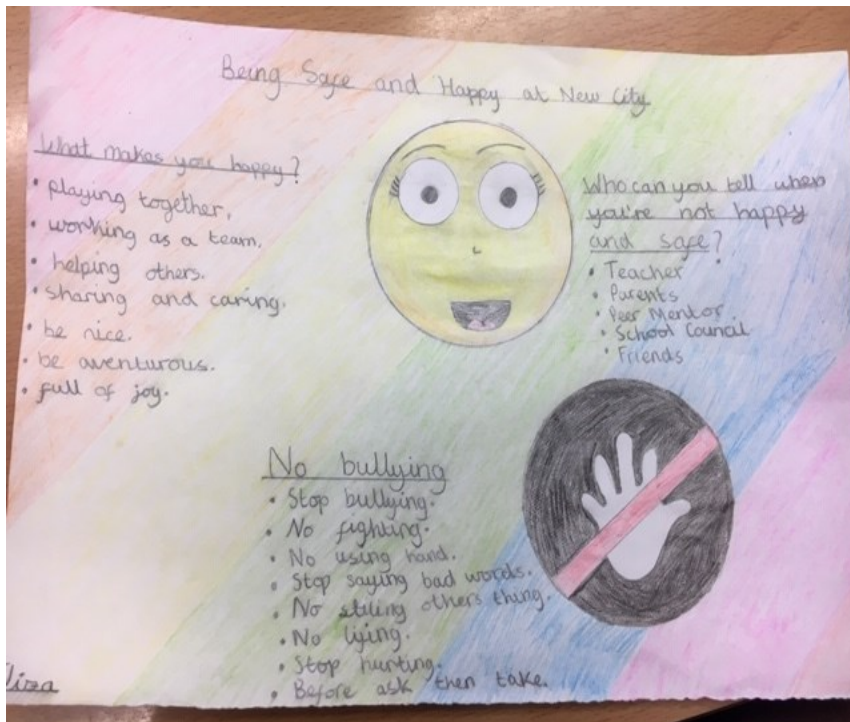
Afraid of failure, afraid of a creature
