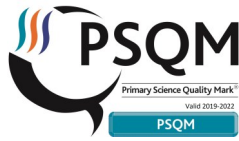

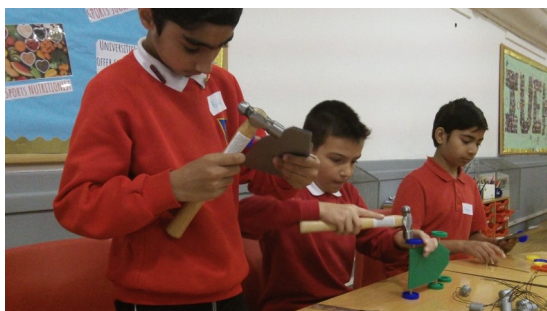
Attendance at New City
