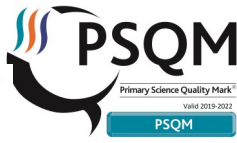

Black History Month

Did you know?

The Ivory Bangle Lady was a wealthy black woman who lived in Roman Britain almost 1400 years ago. We know that she was wealthy because she was buried with lots of jewellery and coins.

John Blanke lived 500 years ago and was known as the 'Black Trumpeteer'. He was the most famous black person in Tudor England.

Mary Prince was the first black professional writer to get published. She had to fight hard to be seen as a 'free woman in England.

Lilian Baddar was the first black woman to join the RAF and fought in World War 2.

The children enjoyed learning about these 'Hidden Figures' and using artefacts to make interpretations.

PE at New City

At New City, P.E. plays a significant role in school life. Children in all year groups take part in two hours of high quality P.E. lessons a week. We employ coaches to provide specialist training in specific sports and we provide a variety of high quality equipment to engage and support all of our pupils. Our fantastic curriculum includes sports such as softball, orienteering, fencing, cycling, box fit and ultimate frisbee amongst many others. Our clubs are just as exciting ranging from archery to cheerleading and even Tai Chi!

At New City Primary School, we value the role of Physical Education (PE) in the promotion of health, co-ordination and well-being. Children have two sessions of PE every week. We employ a range of experts to support our pupils' acquisition and development of skills in a variety of sports. However, we cannot allow pupils to participate in PE lessons without the correct kit and trainers.

All pupils must wear the correct PE kit for health and safety reasons. The PE kit consists of:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Plain black/blue joggers or shorts
- Trainers (outdoors) or plimsolls (indoors)
- Plain black/blue pull-on hijab

We're Going To Find The Monster

Charlie and Eddie are playing in the garden one morning when Dad gives them a ten-minute warning for breakfast. They know that they have to find the grumpy, prickly monster, but where will they find him? The brave brother and sister set off on a journey of adventure over shimmering oceans, high mountains and past fierce tigers to discover the terrifying monster in his lair: or, as it turns out, their teenage brother Marcus in his bedroom. A lovely slightly fairy tale-inspired tale about a family with two younger siblings and a teenager getting ready for breakfast, *We're Going to Catch a Monster* features the wonderful storytelling and word wizardry of former Children's Laureate Malorie Blackman and the brilliant eye for family dynamics from prize-winning illustrator Dapo Adeola.
