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#### Baseball 5 Brings Families Together at New City

'As part of BaseballSoftballUK's commitment to developing baseball and softball opportunities in East London, specifically targeting the boroughs surrounding the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park where the Major League Baseball London Series took place, we launched a pilot Baseball5 family project with New City Primary School in the London Borough of Newham.

By utilising <u>Baseball5</u>, an urban version of the game supported by the WBSC that can be played anywhere with just one ball, BSUK's Development team targeted Year Three and Year Four pupils, as well as their families, from New City Primary School to show them that they can easily be active together.'

Little Big Baseball Club' took place on Mondays after school over a six week period. The club was oversubscribed, attracting approximately 20 participants each week. Pupils were only allowed to attend the club if they were accompanied by a family member. Parents were taught the skills and ways in which they can take part in the game with their families allowing them to grow confidence and self-esteem, establish a greater family bond and have fun making new friends. To help sustain participation BaseballSoftballUK gave away Baseball5 balls at the end of the programme to each of the families so they were able to continue playing in their own time.

Well done to Mr Archer and our families for their commitment to the Little Big Baseball Club. Once again New City has received national recognition. Mr Archer has since been nominated for the Softball Coach of the Year award. We will keep you posted on his nomination
