Across the school we have been learning about feeling safe and happy at New City. Below are some examples of children's work.


Feeling Safe at New City

Yearning to feel safe, deep inside Emotions that you shouldn't hide Sometimes it's hard to be secure There are so many things you're not very sure


Afraid of failure, afraid of a creature Trying to always please your teacher What's on your mind, what do you think find the reasons, find the link
