#### Visit to Westfield

Children with SEND need learning opportunities in environments that recognise the challenges they face on a daily basis and provide them with strategies to manage and develop life skills. At New City we constantly evaluate the learning experiences our children with SEND receive.

Last week Thursday we provided a learning experience out of school within the community. Our SEND team made a trip to Westfield. All children and adults used public transport from school to Stratford. During the visit to Westfield they were given a shopping task to complete. Children were supported to buy ingredients for their weekly cooking session at school. With support everyone had a walk through the supermarket, finding items on their shopping list and using money to pay for it at check out. The trip was very successful. We even had time to go up and down on the escalators!





### Reading Winter Challenge

The Winter Reading Challenge is about to begin!

As so many of our children took part and successfully completed the Summer Reading Challenge, we would like to encourage everyone to take part in the Winter Reading challenge this month.

The aim of the challenge, similarly to the Summer Reading

The children will collect their certificate at the library either from the library staff or by going online and printing it off themselves.
