
Thank you to everyone who comes to school everyday in their full school uniform. The children look so smart. Please ensure that all children have black shoes or plain black trainers.




Times tables Rock Stars






Mr Freeland's Book Review

My Monster and Me

Everybody gets anxious sometimes - but if the anxiety grows so big that it impacts on a child's ability to play or go out with friends, it needs addressing. In this delightful picture book, a boy introduces both himself and his monster, who has been with him for as long as he can remember. It is big and bossy and has a tendency to get in the way and stop him doing what he wants to do. It also hides itself from his parents. And now it is enormous. This is such an effective book for reminding us all that though anxiety issues (or anger issues or indeed other mental health challenges) may be a part of life, they do not define us, and with the right strategies they can be managed.
