Head Lice

HOW TO CHECK FOR HEAD LICE

You should regularly check your child's scalp for signs of lice or nits - checking early will reduce the head lice problem and infections from lice bites.

Weekly checks during the back-to-school season are wise, and these **3** simple steps make it easy to get into a routine of checking for and preventing head lice.

STEP 1

Coat the hair thoroughly with a thick white conditioner or a solution specially formulated for combing out nits and head lice

STEP 2

Divide the hair down the centre of the head and secure one side of the hair with a clip.

STEP 3

Starting from the base of the neck, divide the loose hair into 4cm wide sections and comb through the hair with a nit comb root to tip. Wipe the comb with a tissue and repeat, working your way toward the front of the head.
