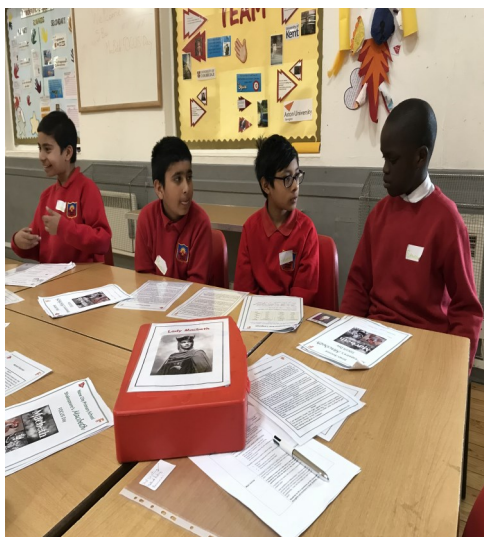

This week year 5 once again visited the IntoUniversity team, this time for the day. The children recapped their learning of University life and played games to support them in understanding responsibilities they may have to undertake. The children then enhanced their learning of Macbeth with a carousel of activities which enabled them to learn about different aspects of the story. They learnt about method acting and iambic pentameter, along with other important themes in the Shakespearian story. In the afternoon the children participated in a drama workshop where they used rapping techniques to understand the opening scene to Macbeth. They were wonderfully well behaved and thoroughly enjoyed the experience.

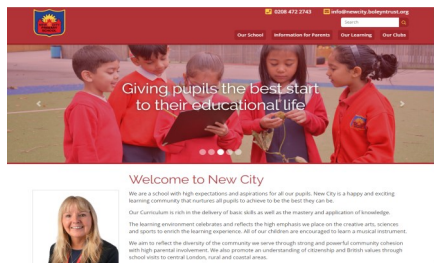
